Teacher Checklist

Use this teacher checklist to make sure that you are ready to start your class on CodeHS!

Teacher Prep

- Set up a teacher account at <https://CodeHS.com>
- Get started with CodeHS content so you are familiar with the video tutorials and exercises that your students will be completing during class
- Explore teacher resources including lesson plans, problem guides, exercise handouts and more from your teacher page
- Add your class(es) from your teacher page

Classroom Prep

- Make sure you have enough computers for everyone in your class
- Make sure students have an email address that they can use to sign up for CodeHS
- Ensure that all computers have an up-to-date web browser installed (ideally Chrome)
- Ensure that you have good internet access (students will be watching videos through their web browser)
- Provide headphones or ask students to bring in head phones

During Your First Class

- Have students sign up for your class by sending them this link <http://codehs.com/go> and your class code
- Allow students to work at their own pace through CodeHS course content - watching short videos, looking through example code, and completing coding exercises
- Lead class activities outlined in the exercise handouts
- Lead class discussions using discussion questions provided in the syllabus

After Class

- View class progress by activity, lesson, or module by clicking on the links on the left side of your class page
- Check individual student progress by clicking on any individual student
- Check and respond to student help questions by clicking on the “Help Questions and Submissions” link on the left of your class page
- Check for and grade student submissions by clicking on the “Help Questions and Submissions” link on the left of your class page
